

Limpopo bribe cop charged

Polokwane - A police constable appeared before the Mahwelereng Magistrate's Court on Wednesday for allegedly demanding a bribe from a motorist, Limpopo police said.

"It is alleged the suspect demanded R1 000 from a motorist who failed to report an accident," police spokesperson Mohale Ramatseba said.

Members of the Organised Crime Unit caught the police official, Makgoba George Mahlamela, on October 22 after he allegedly received the R1 000 from the motorist.

Ramatseba said the case was postponed to November 25 and Mahlamela was granted R1 000 bail.

Police investigations would continue.
